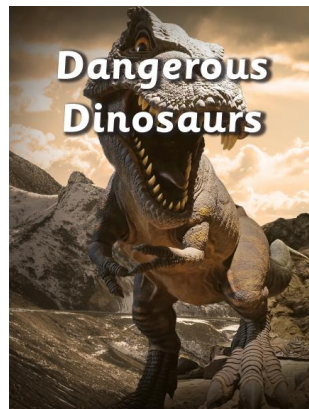


Please try to complete at least 4 of these activities over this half term at school. They link to our topics 'Dangerous Dinosaurs' and 'Puddles and Rainbows'.

RECEPTION Home Learning: Spring 2

On a rainy day find three puddles.

Which looks the widest?
Measure them with string.

Which is the deepest? How can you find out?

Share the Dangerous Dinosaurs Did You Know? facts and key words (attached in email) with a family member. Choose three of the keywords and write a short sentence using each.

There are lots of animals alive today that have relatives that were alive at the same time as the dinosaurs. Research the following prehistoric creatures:
megalodon, archelon
tyrannosaurus, sarcosuchus.
Which animals might be their modern-day relatives?

Visit the Natural History Museum - Discover Dinosaurs website

(www.nhm.ac.uk/discover/dinosaurs) to find out more about fossils. Make salt dough by mixing 1 cup of plain flour, $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of salt and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water. Use the salt dough to make a dinosaur skeleton.

Use paints, slime, gloop, chalk or any other material you can think of to experiment with colour mixing. Begin with the primary colours: red, yellow and blue. Which colours can you mix from these base colours?

Look at your book collection at home. Which are fiction and which are non-fiction books? Visit the library or a book shop and choose a non-fiction book about dinosaurs to read.
