

Things you can do at home to support your child in Pippin Class

Reading

Read with your child every day – this includes all the extra elements of the Read, Write, Inc. books, like speed words and answering the questions. If you prefer, focus on a different aspect each time you read with them.

Writing

Practise writing about real events making sure that they use full stops, capital letters and questions marks (if appropriate).

Encourage the children to write sentences using **or /and /but** and **when / if / that /because**.

Maths

Activities can include:

Reading and writing the numbers to 100.

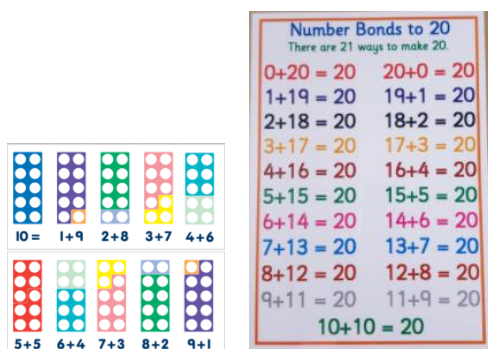
Counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s. If they can begin to chant the times tables with them.

Using and recognising all the different coins.

Telling the time using an analogue clock.

Recognising and naming the 2d and 3d shapes. (See video on Bradfield Library page for 3d shapes)

Recalling and using number bonds to 10, then 20 and then 100.
