## Henry

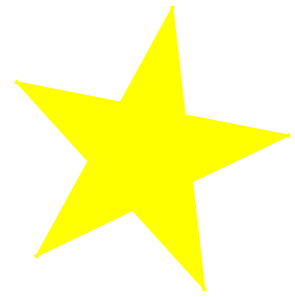
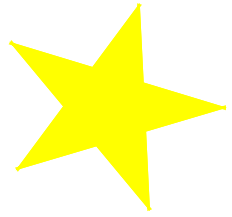
