Sol recently won a local tournament with his team Lawford UIOs.

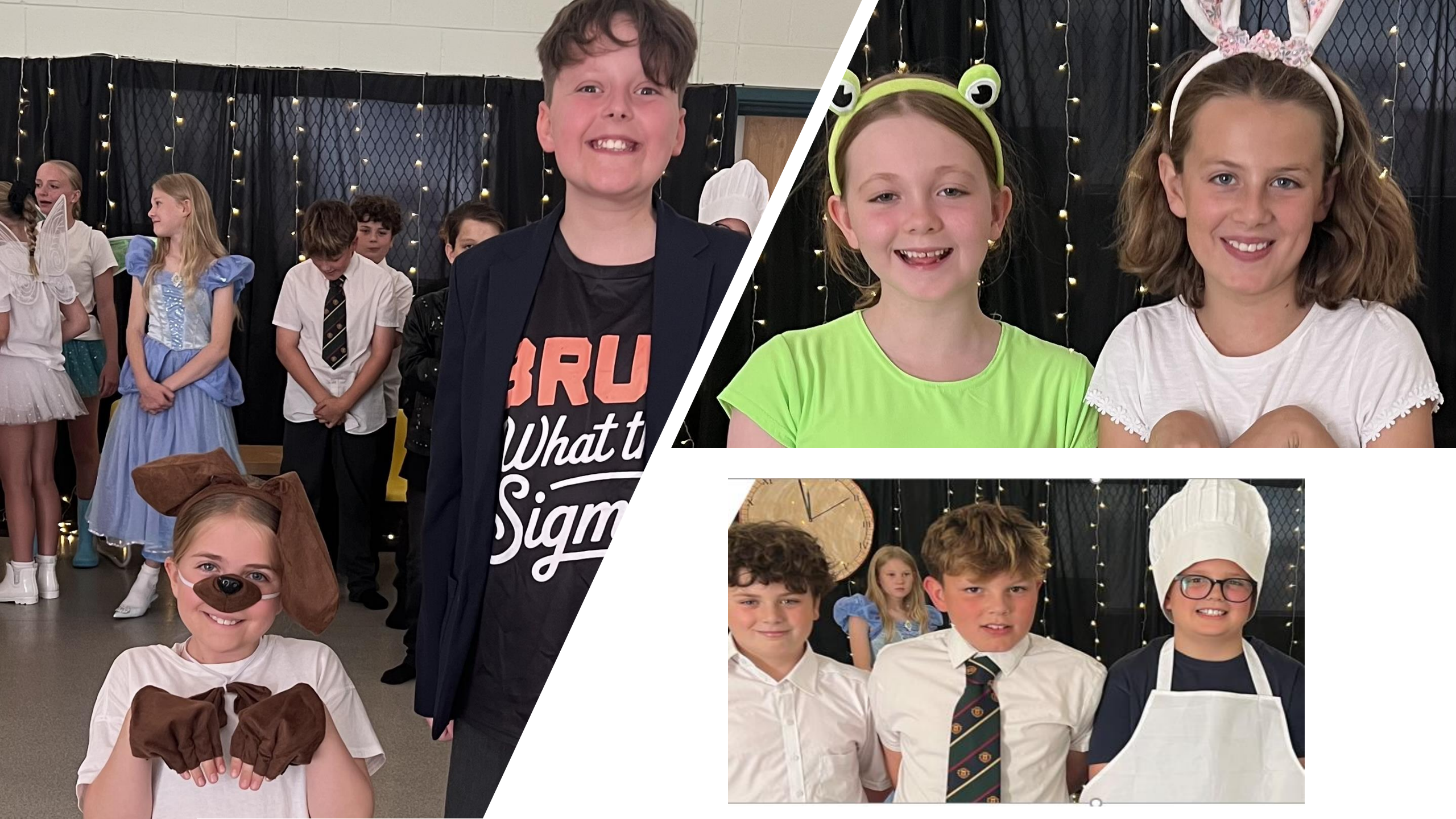

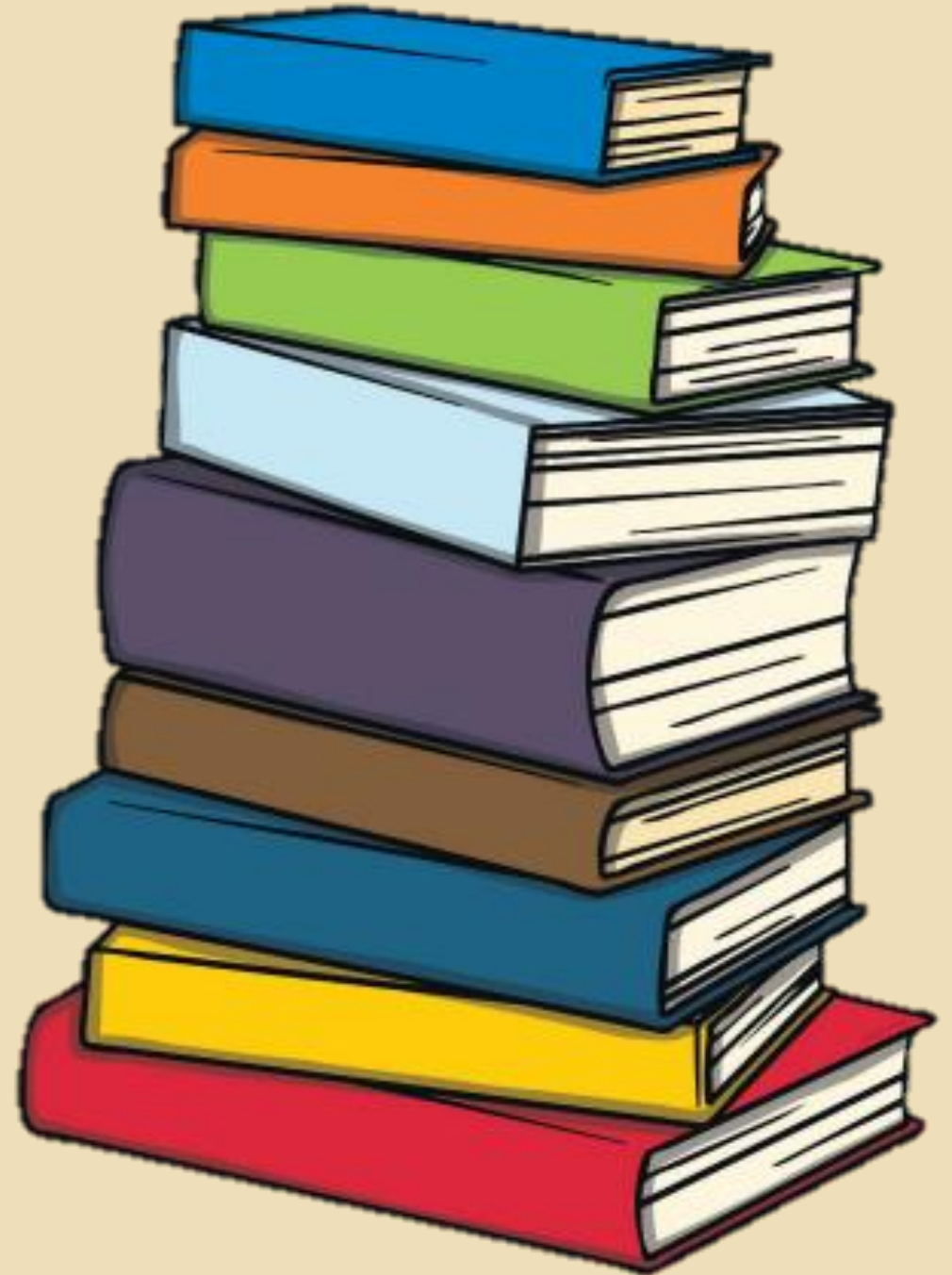

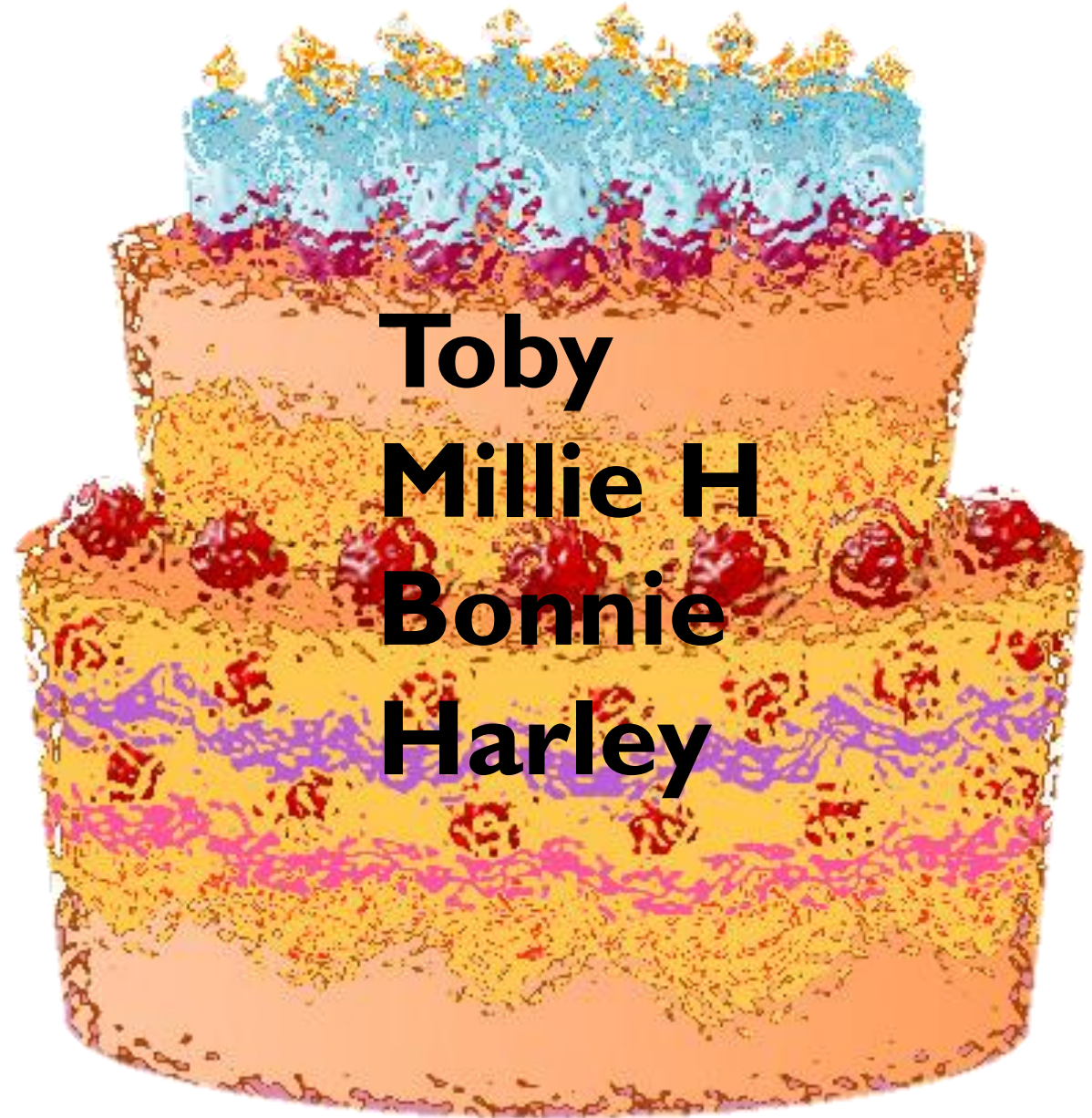
