# Dad's Day

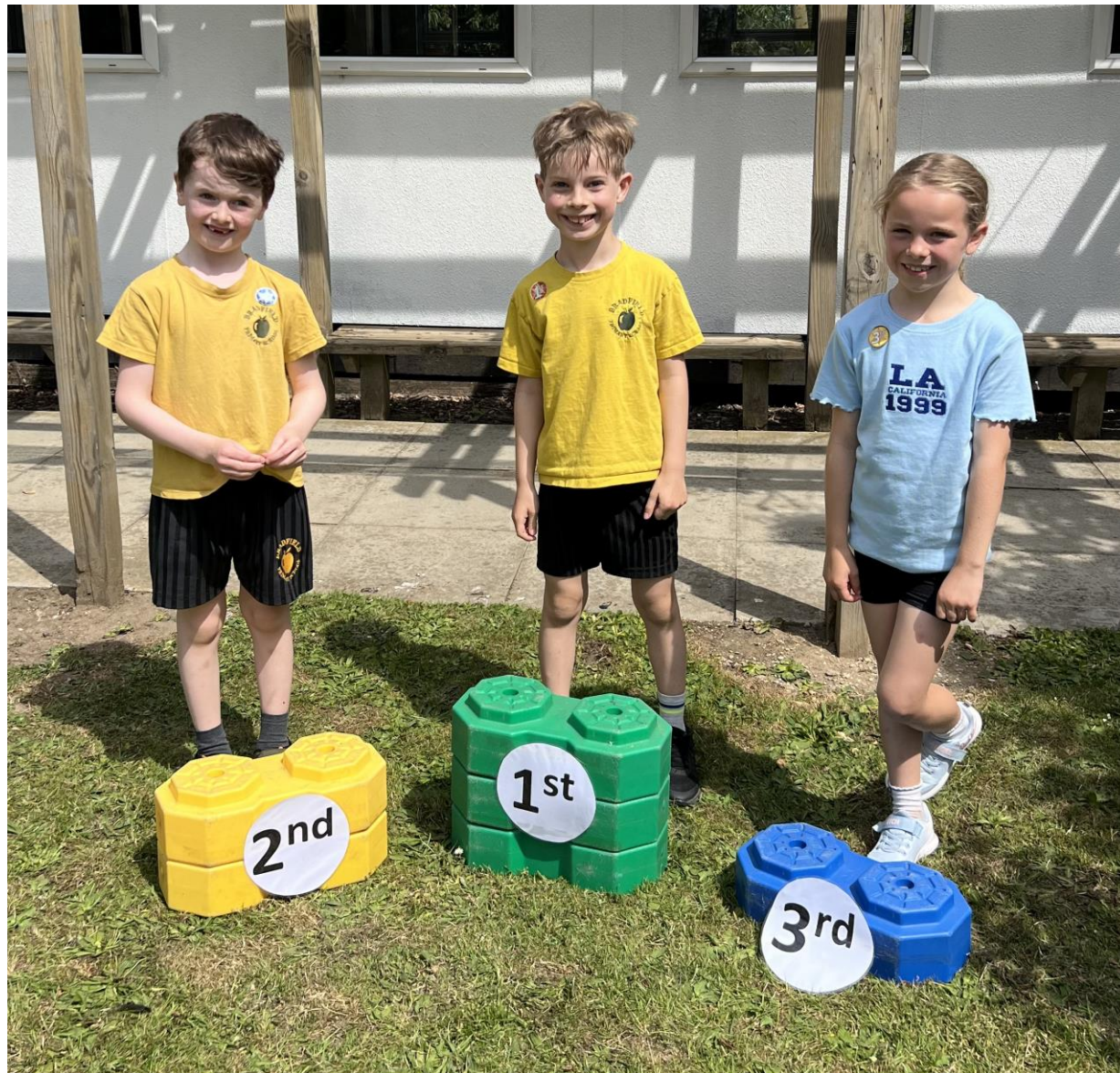

- There will be a maximum time limit of 3 minutes for each act.
- Finalists must be prepared perform again on Wednesday 2nd July in the school hall (9.30am). Parents of finalists will be invited to attend.
- Voting to go through to the finals will be on the basis of the most votes cast by the children. (1 vote person)
- Voting for the overall winner/s will be decided by the most votes cast for an individual act.

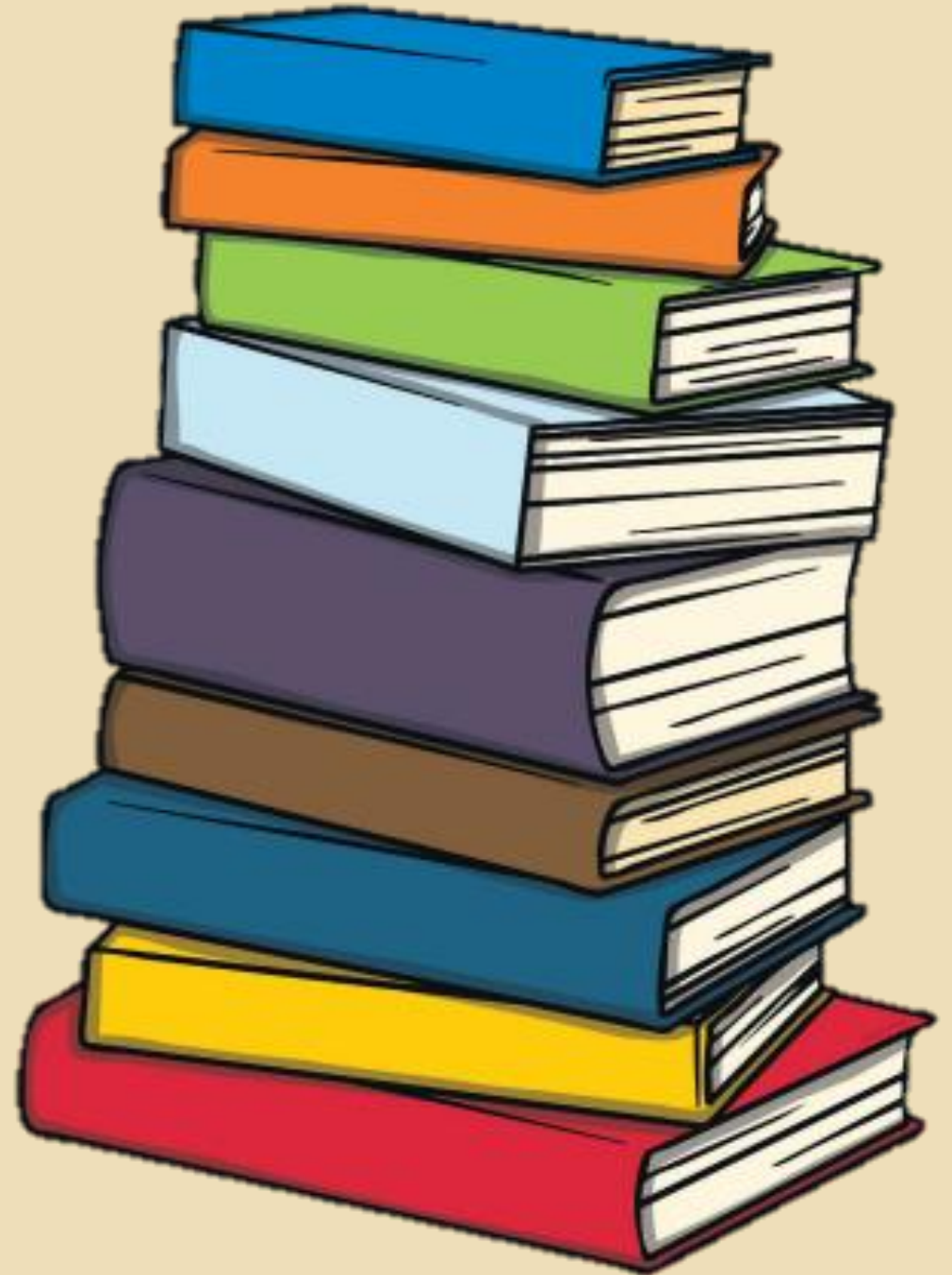
