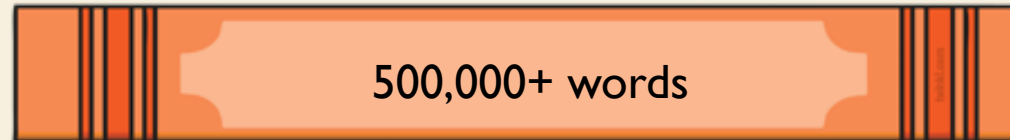
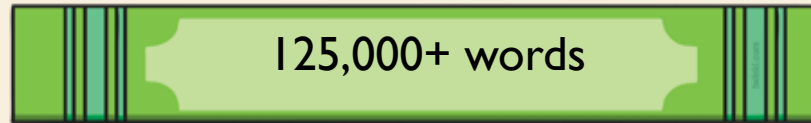


# MILESTONE READERS...

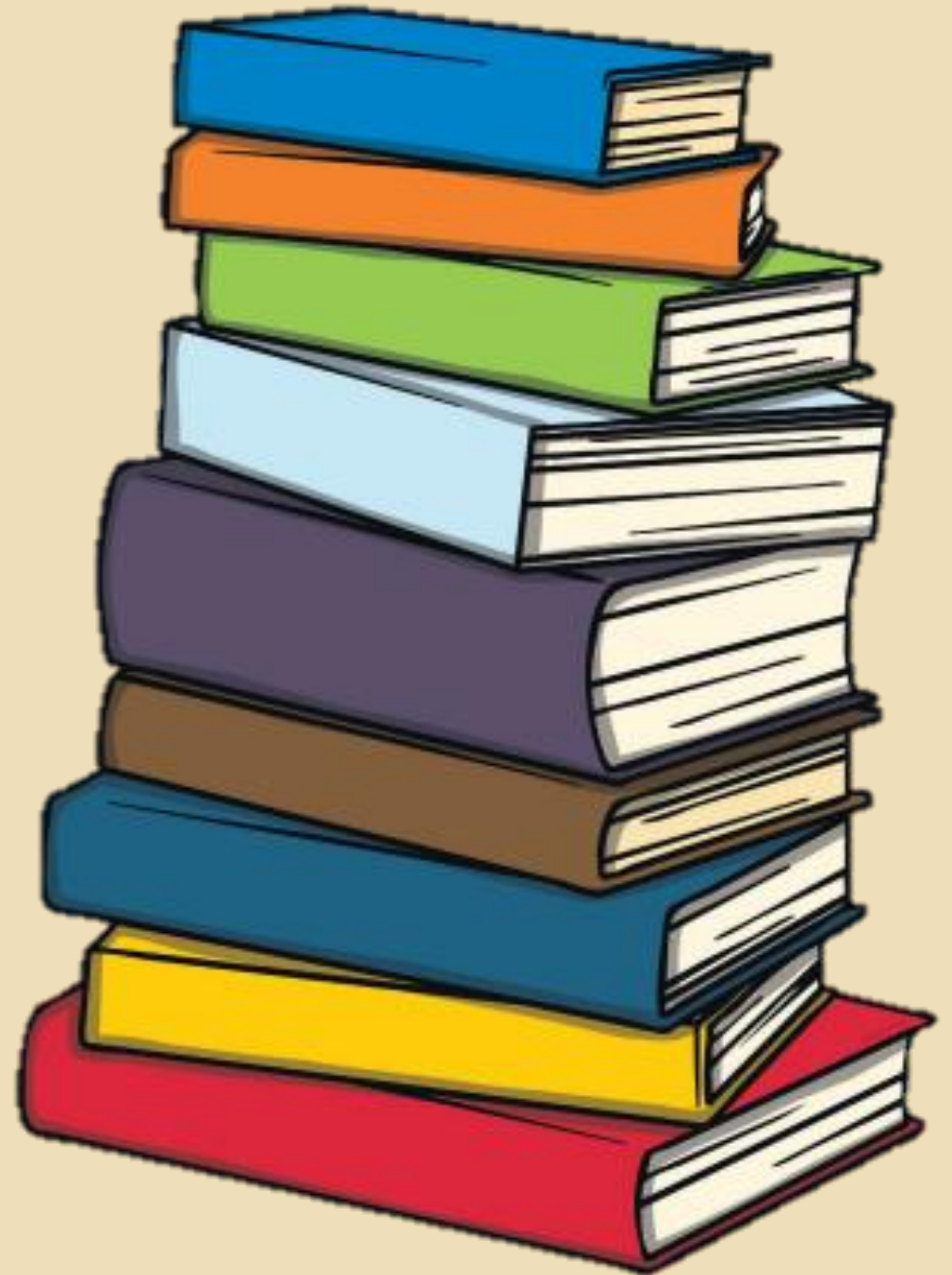
