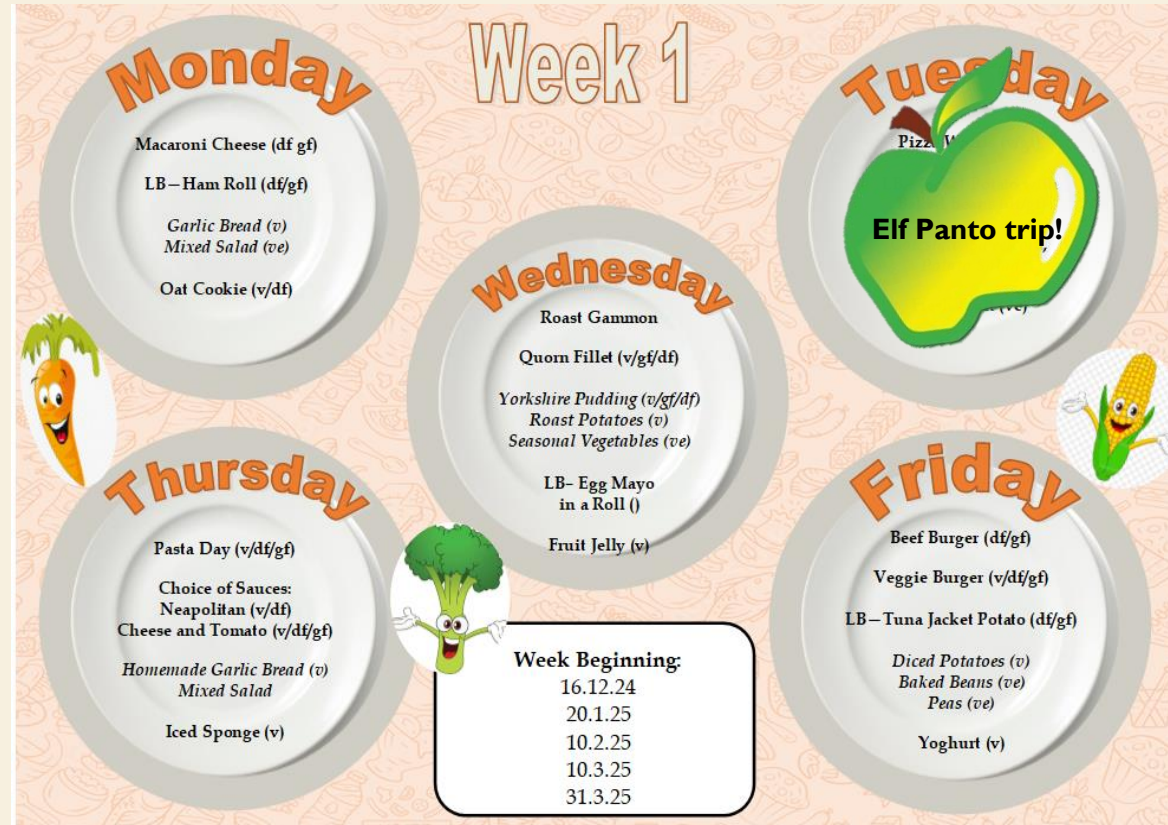

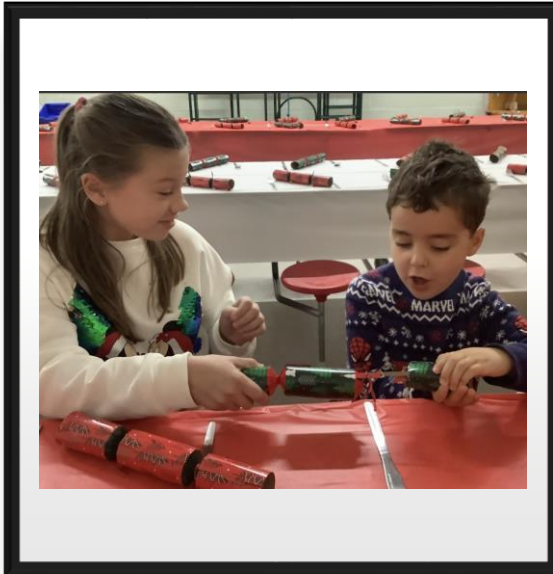
### **Aurora and Luna**

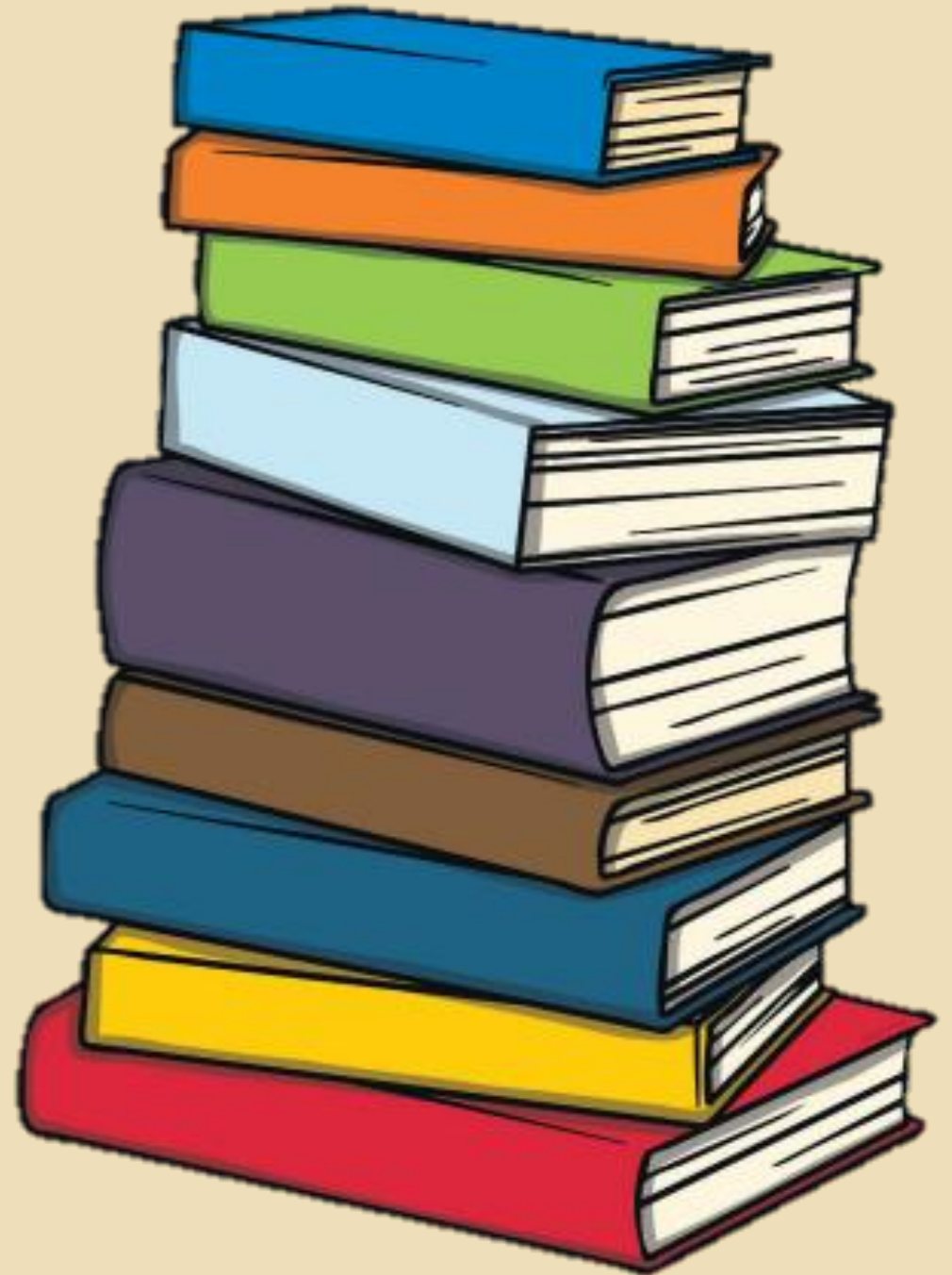

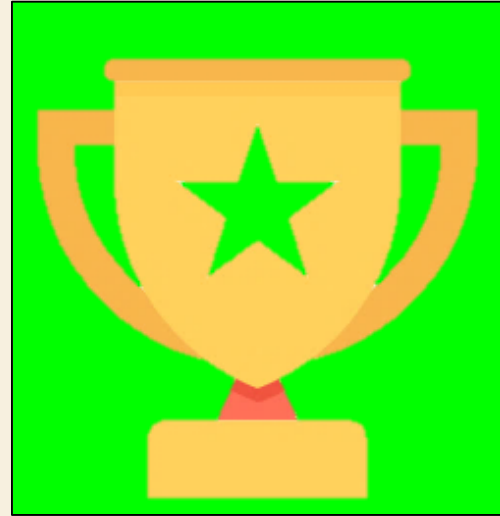
