It is great to see so many parents taking up the opportunity to conveniently pre-order lunches using our School Money app. It is a very easy system to use, you simply log in and then select the lunch choices your child would like for the week ahead.

By using the app to pre-order lunches, you're not just making things easier for yourselves, but also helping Mr Jones, our Cook, to plan in advance and ensure we have the right amounts of food prepared. Pre-ordering also assists in budgeting and helps keep down food costs, which benefits everyone.

Just remember to remind your child what they'll be having for lunch each day, as once the orders are placed and cooked, they won't be able to change their choices. We cook only for the numbers we have for that day, so it's important to stick to the pre-ordered meals.

While it's still possible to order a lunch on the day, we encourage parents to establish a habit of pre-ordering whenever possible. Thank you for your co-operation and support!

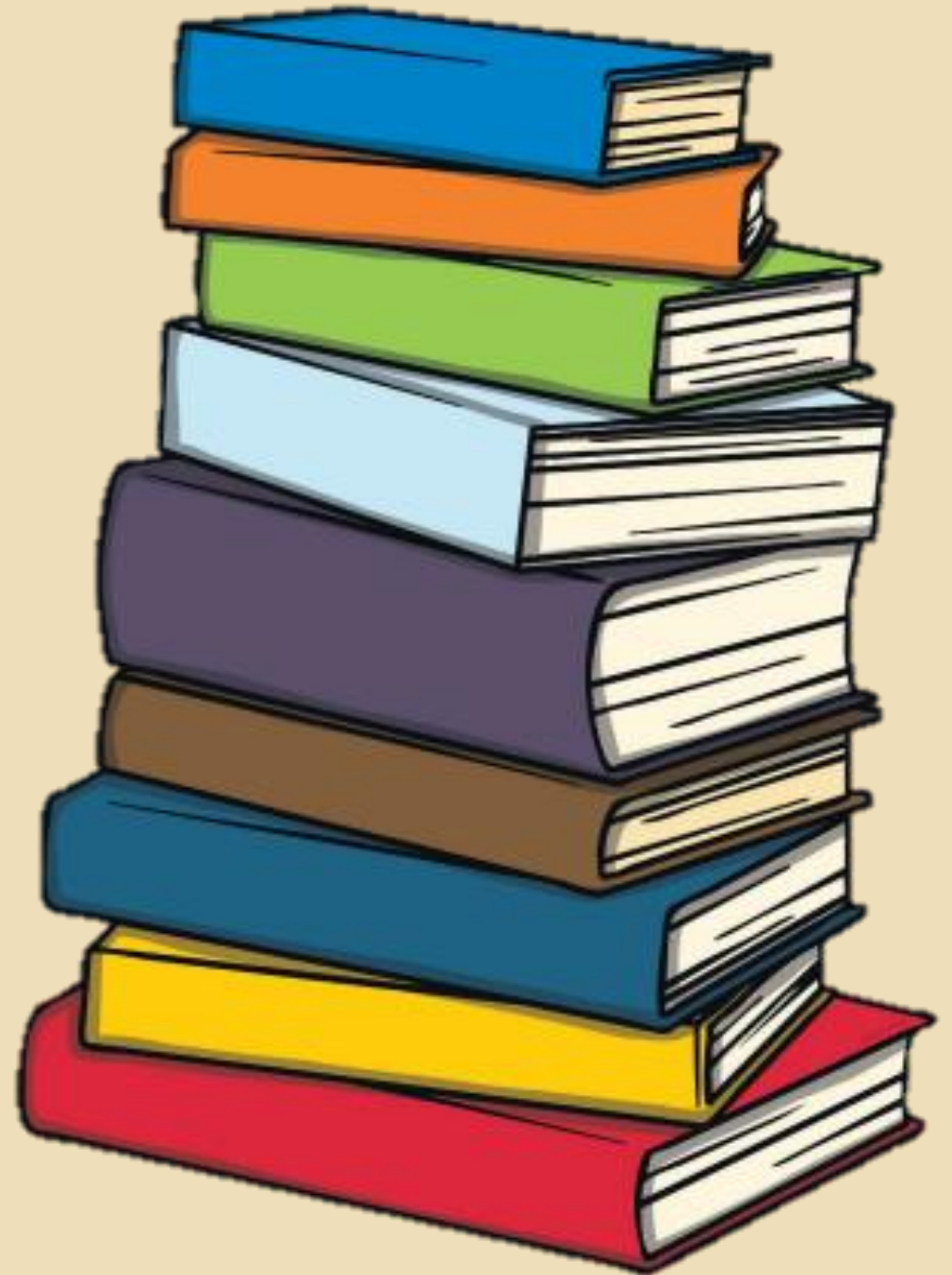

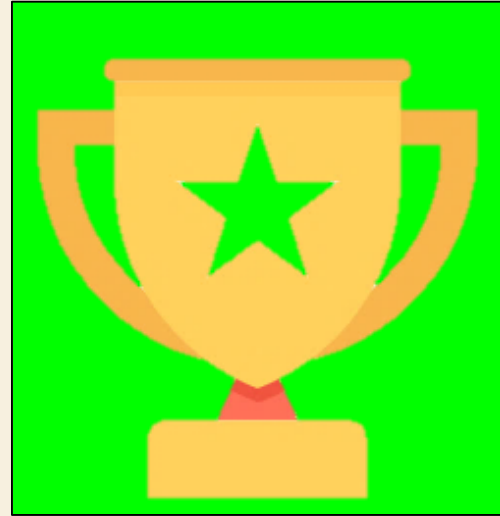
