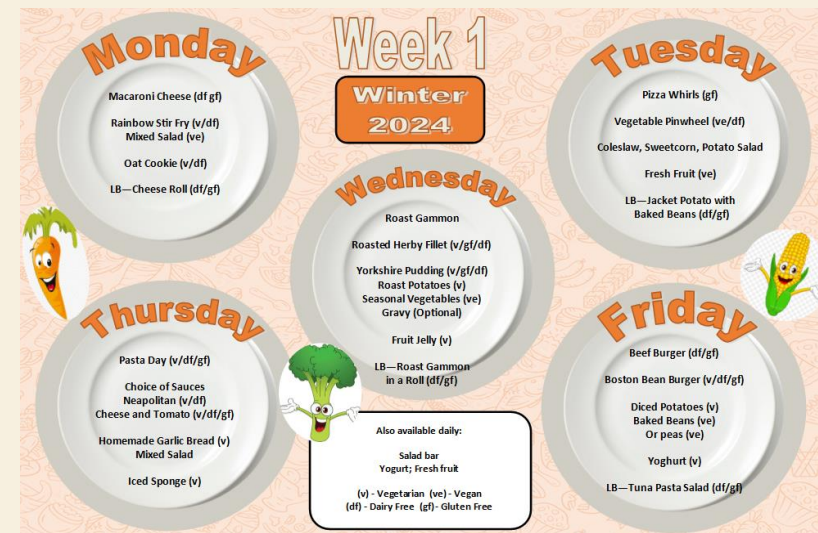

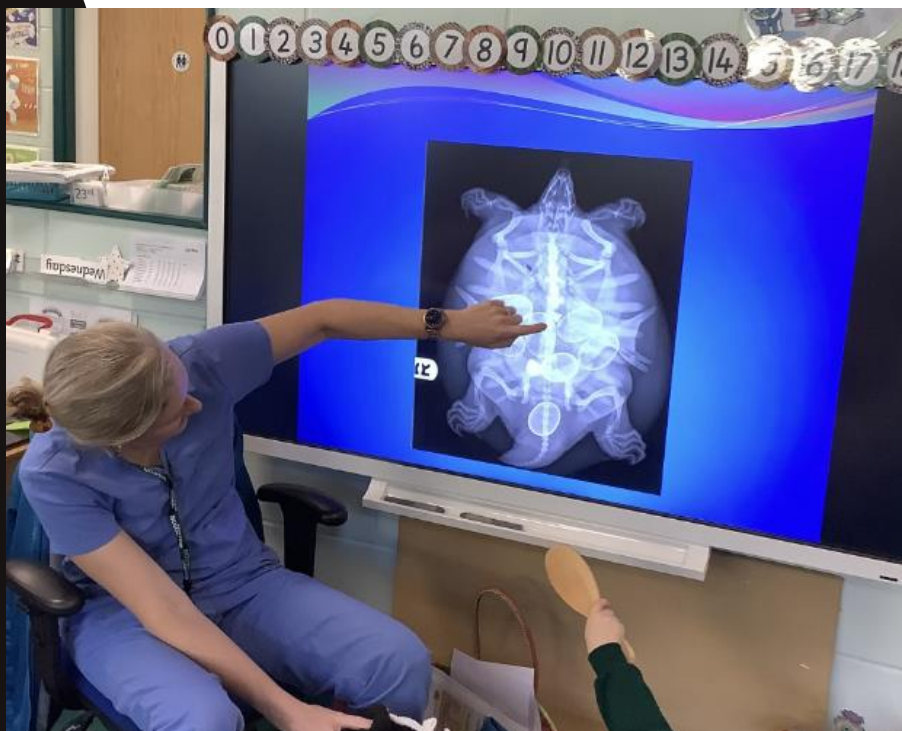
Millie has been enjoying experimenting with oil paints on a variety of canvases. These are some of her recent masterpieces!

As part of our way to celebrate the successes in reading, children on the Accelerated Reading scheme can earn different awards. Children are rewarded for each milestone of words achieved.

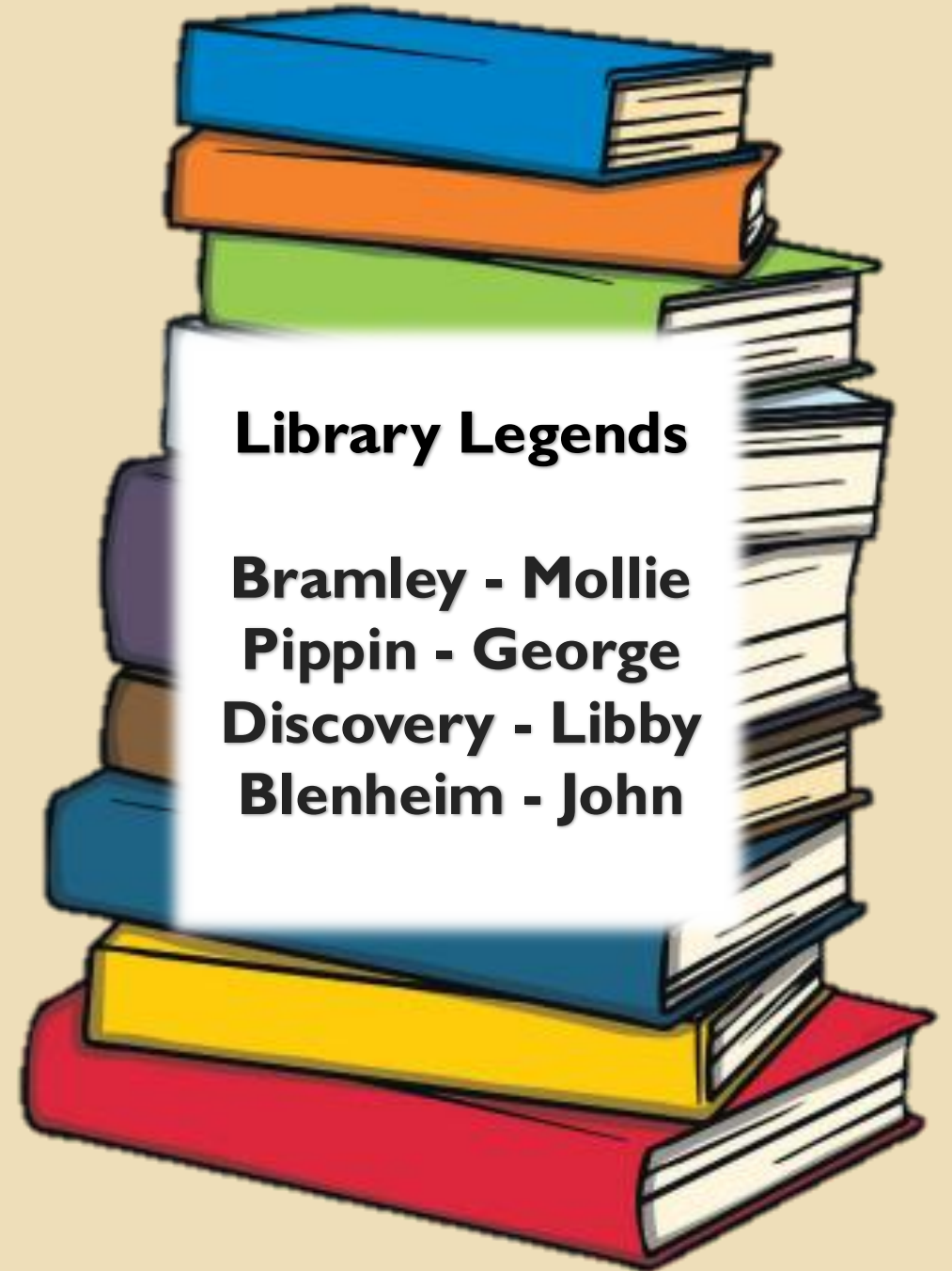

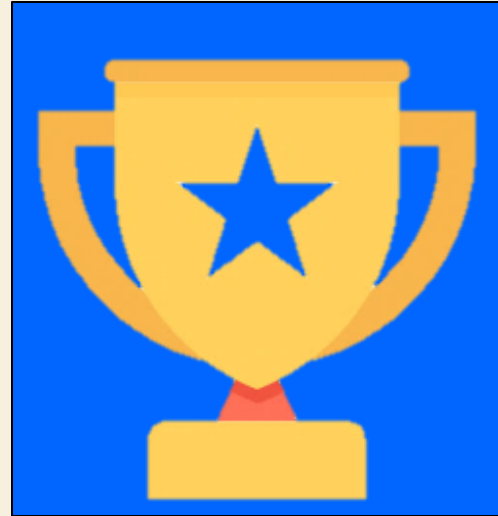
